



Each and every Wednesday morning-for 47 years, the members of Piece Corps meet at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Fellowship Hall from 8:00am to 11:30am to assemble guilts. There are so many people who help make this ministry possible: the sewers, fabric cutters, ironers, quilt tiers, quilt binders, those who supply us with donations of fabric, batting, thread, and money, and finally— those who pack-up and transport the guilts to Monroe, Wisconsin and load them on the semi so they get to the people who need them.

Each year, on Quilt Sunday, the church is draped with quilts. We thank God that He has given us Work to do that impacts so many others. We will never know all the people who benefit from our quilts; but we know God's Love and Work is never done; and so each year we strive to do our best.

Lutherdale Camp: 6 blankets.


### St, Joseph Catholic Church in Stockton:
