RESUSCIATATION vs RESURRECTION

Last week ten members of Good Shepherd gathered to learn how to help save a life. They were trained on an AED and given CPR instructions.

An automated external defibrillator (AED) is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and ventricular tachycardia in a patient, and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electrical therapy which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm. (Wow! That's a mouthful!)

With simple audio and visual commands, AEDs are designed to be simple to use for the layperson.

Saving a life and bringing a dead person back to life are two different matters. The first may be done with an AED or CPR. But only God can *create* life again through Resurrection. Layperson (as it says above) can *revive*, but only God intervenes to bring about *new life*.

The writer in the Book of Revelation quotes the Spirit as saying, "Behold, I make all things new!" It is that newness of life, now and in the future, that we celebrating on Easter. We do not say that Christ was resuscitated. We say that God raised him from the dead. That's Resurrection.

That's why we confidently and boldly sing: "Jesus Christ is risen today. Alleluia!"

The Assembly will be held Thursday, June 16 through Saturday, June 18 at Augustana College, Rock Island, IL. The current tentative agenda has registration beginning at 11:30 a.m., with the Opening of the Assembly scheduled for 2:00 p.m. in Centennial Hall. The Assembly is scheduled to end, as usual, on the afternoon of Saturday, June 18. Secondly, because the Synod has not had a Bishop election without an incumbent for nearly 18 years, congregations will be contacted in mid-February with a request for the names and contact information for elected Lay Voting Members, in order that they may receive important Election Information

prior to actual Registration for the Synod Assembly.

Voting members should be equally divided between male and female according to Constitutional Provision +S7.21.c. ... normally one of whom shall be male and one of whom shall be female... Also, please keep in mind when selecting your voting members the Synod Constitutional Bylaw S7.21.A87. (Chapter 7, Synod Assembly: It is the intention of this Synod that normally there shall be no more than one voting member of the Synod Assembly from a single household.) In addition, each congregation may register one additional voting member as a youth (Synod Constitutional Bylaw S7.21.A11... a voting member who has not reached the age of 18 at the time of election or appointment for service) **OR** one young adult (Synod Constitutional Bylaw S7.21.A11...a voting member between the ages of 18 and 30 at the time of election or appointment for service). We also would encourage your congregation to elect one or two al-

ternates to attend as visitors this year with the possibility of their attending as voting members at next year's Assembly. Although this procedure would be more costly to your congregation, your congregation will benefit by future voting members observing the Assembly operation one year and, thus, being better prepared to represent your congregation the following year at Assembly. (Note: VISITORS are welcome to attend the Assembly and are requested to send in a registration.

GOOD SHEPHERD CONGREGATION is allowed TWO (2) Voting Members, plus one (1) additional Youth OR Young Adult.




Sunday School offerings this fall will go towards ELCA's God's Global Barnyard. All of the animals in God's


