## The SHEPHERD'S VOICE October 2016

"For lo, the one who forms the mountains, creates the wind, reveals his thoughts to mortals, makes the morning darkness, and treads on the heights of the earth—the Lord, the God of hosts, is his name!" (Amos 4:3)

Greetings. My name is Miho (pronounced MEE HO) Yasukawa, I am the new pastor at Good Shepherd. This is my first call, and I started on September 1<sup>st</sup>. This is my first time in Northwest Illinois, and this is a beautiful part of Illinois. Everything is new to me, and every day I am learning something new. I am thankful for your support, help, patience, and loving care. Thank you.

The church is a place filled with surprises. Unexpected things happen all the time. A recent surprise came from our confirmation youth. We were working on our faith statements, picking favorite Bible verses or stories and sharing why we liked them. Some already had ideas about their favorites, and others were still looking for a favorite verse or story. One night we were helping each other find Bible verses for those who were still searching. While flipping around the Bible and listening to an adult leader's favorite verse in Psalms, one youth suddenly expressed, "I like this one." He read what he found and shared which parts struck him. Somehow the Spirit came down and was guiding this youth. Another youth raised a question about innocent suffering. It made me think about God's providence when we hear news about war, violence, natural disasters, and disease. While listening to the youth expressing their thoughts, I realized that even while we are young, we experience suffering. We know that there are ups and downs in our lives.

Some words in Amos spoke to me. Amos was a prophet from Tekoa in the southern kingdom of Judah after the ancient Hebrews had split into two kingdoms. He was "a

herdsman and a dresser of sycamore trees" (Amos 7:14) but God appointed him to speak God's message to the northern kingdom, Israel. The book of Amos is filled with words of judgment against Israel. When we read Amos, we are surprised by the sudden appearance of a hymn of praise. In Amos 4:13 the prophet praises our God proclaiming God as the one who creates the wind, and who makes the morning darkness. Amos continued to profess that God is the one "who made the Pleiades and Orion, and turns deep darkness into the morning, and darkens the day into night, who calls for the waters of the sea, and pours them out on the surface of the earth." (Amos 5:8)

In our good days and bad days, we can be sure that God is the creator of this universe, and God's love for this world never ends. May the love of God always surround us. Pr. Miho


