If you are thinking about your New Year's resolution for 2018, I encourage you to be the vessels and eyes and ears and hands and feet for God's joy because as you know, God's joy is love. May you be filled with God's joy today.

Highlights from December Council Meetings

- Jay Andrews presented the Treasurer's Report. The November gas bill was \$243.00 and the electric bill was \$154.34.
 A motion to approve the report was made by Troy Doubler and seconded by Gene Hesselbacher. All approved.
- Pastor Miho presented her monthly report which included information on a Youth Owl Night, similar to a lock-in, Dec.
 22. Youth will spend the night filled with activities at the church. More adult volunteers are needed.
- More volunteers would be appreciated to make visits or phone calls to shut-ins or home bound parishioners. Those interested are asked to contact Pastor.
- Coralyn Hudik, on behalf of the Stewardship Committee, said estimates are being sought for a 4-inch by 8-inch cling-on that would feature Good Shepherd. The cling-on can be applied to vehicles. Several design options are being considered.
- Kristy Patterson updated the Council on the upcoming Children's Christmas Program set for Dec. 17 and Denny Luke, Finance Committee, said a Dec. 18 meeting is set to discuss the 2018.
- Troy Doubler, Property Committee, said adjustments are being made to the outdoor railings.
- Nominating Committee member Cora Hudik, said Council nominees are being sought for the upcoming term. Outgoing members are Cora Hudik, Tim Gordon and Karen Niemeier.

Highlights from December Council Meetings Cont.

- Jay Andrews said the yearly treasurer's audit has been completed. On behalf of the Men's Group, Andrews said the following donations were made: \$250 to ELCA; \$100 to WELCA; \$100 to the church to cover utilities, etc., \$100 to Danica Balbach for her mission trip; and \$600 to the Peace Corps for quilt batting.
- In future items, Pastor Miho presented a Vision for 2018 Making God Smile. Throughout the coming year she would like the congregation to deepen its relationship with God through thought, reflection and sharing how we make God smile in our everyday lives. These moments can be shared through the newsletter, worship, the Facebook page and the church bulletin board.
- Troy Doubler said more volunteers are needed to operate the sound board for worship services. This is an adult position.
- A complete copy of minutes will be posted on the bulletin board.




