### COUNCIL MOVES FORWARD WITH IMPROVEMENTS

Your church council is aware of their responsibilities to maintain and improve our facilities. They recently voted to move ahead and net new energy efficient windows for the educational wing of the church facilities. The cost is around \$10,000. This expense will come from existing funds that are available.

During a wind storm a couple of months ago many of the shingles on the educational unit blew off. The council recently voted to replace them with steeling roofing. The cost is \$15,000 of which approximately \$11,000 will come from the insurance company. The council believes that the steel roof is a good investment for the future.

### CALL COMMITTEE AT WORK

The Call Committee met several weeks ago with Assistant to the Bishop, Pastor Denver Bittner. The Synod had received our extensive Church Profile and he had the profile of a pastoral candidate to share with us. However, as the committee was making preparations to arrange an interview the candidate decided to withdraw his name for consideration. While we did not get to meet or talk directly to him it was the consensus of some that this candidate would be better placed in a larger metropolitan area. Since then the Call Committee has received the profiled of another candidate which they are now considering. Obviously the name and information about the candidates must remain confidential until the Call Committee recommends the candidate. We are glad that things appear to be moving along swiftly. The next step would be to present the candidate's profile to the church council and ultimately to the congregation. We'll keep you posted.




